Anna Barriball makes work which moves between the languages of drawing and sculpture.

Barriball often uses the practice of drawing to create something which might be understood as sculpture. Sheets of paper pressed insistently by her pencil up against windows, walls and doors become heavily material objects. Things in the world – windbreaks, found photographs, a fireplace – are redrawn as artworks through subtle alteration.
