Arts Access: Client Information

About the Service

Artlink's Arts Access service is available to you if you have difficulty getting out and about to arts events and venues. This could be because you use a wheelchair or have other physical disabilities, a sensory impairment, learning difficulty, mental health problem, or are elderly. We offer a door to door service providing you with a volunteer driver and companion for each outing you book.

Booking

You phone in with a request and Artlink arranges the whole outing, booking your tickets, making sure the seats fit your particular requirements, organising transport and finding a volunteer with similar interests to your own.

Costs

There is an annual membership fee of £20.00. You will be invoiced for the cost of your own tickets and an administrative fee of £3 per outing. Artlink will always get you the best available concessionary rate tickets. Artlink pays for the volunteer's ticket and reimburses travel expenses.

What's On

The Artlink office keeps you up-to-date with "what's on" and will send you an events newsletter four times a year. We can also provide you with up-to-date information on the accessibility of venues.

Volunteers

Our volunteers come from many different backgrounds, ranging from those in their early 20s up to retired people who have leisure time available. All our volunteers are interviewed, have to provide references, are Disclosure (Criminal Record) checked and receive training before accompanying you to an arts event.

Please note that due to high demand Arts Access has a waiting list.
