

Arts Access: Volunteer Information

About the Service

Artlink's Arts Access service is used by people who have difficulty getting out and about to arts events and venues. This could be because they use a wheelchair or have some other physical disability, a sensory impairment, learning difficulty, mental health problem, or are elderly. We have around 200 clients who go to a wide variety of events including concerts, theatre, cinema, musicals, galleries and museums.

Artlink aims to make going out to enjoy the arts as easy as possible for our clients by providing a door to door service. We arrange the whole outing – booking tickets in suitable seats, and providing venue information. We match up a client and volunteer with similar interests for each outing. As an Arts Access volunteer you will provide transport and company on outings.

Volunteers

Our volunteers come from many different backgrounds, ranging from those in their early 20s up to retired people who have leisure time available. All our volunteers are interviewed, have to provide references, are Disclosure (Criminal Record) checked and receive training before accompanying one of our clients to an event.

Volunteers are asked to commit to around one or two outings a month. This is very flexible and fits around volunteers' schedules and preferences.

All expenses, including travel and ticket costs are covered.
